





  - Vsak član posadke mora vedeti, kje se lahko dobi njegovo ime in njegove kontaktne možnosti (naslov, e-naslov, tel. številka )
  - Stalna razpoložljivost (365/24)

# Dostop na ladjo


- Posadka, potniki, delavci, obiskovalci...
- Evidenca!!!
- Vsak dostop se mora evidentirati
- Na uradnem dostopu (skali) je stalno prisoten dežurni član posadke
- Uradna procedura (po ladijskem planu)
  - Identifikacija
  - Zapis
  - Kartica
  - Dodelitev spremstva
  - Ostalo

## Somalian Piracy Threat Map (2005-2010)






## How Shipping Companies Try to Protect Their Vessels

- 1** Armed security personnel or dummy soldiers
- 2** Sonic and laser cannons
- 3** Barbed wire and shards
- 4** Blocked entrances
- 5** Lubricant foam on the deck and vessel's side
- 6** Safe room with radio connection

LOOK FOR.....

- Any person without an employee badge, visitor badge or uniform.



# Sumljive osebe



...and ACT



- Determine if the person is an employee or a visitor
  - If an employee, remind them always to display their ID badge and uniform.
  - If a visitor, escort them to the reception area or to the person with whom they are visiting.
  - Report the incident to your immediate supervisor.

# Gibanje v conah omejenega gibanja

- Cone so različne na različnih ladjah
- Cone so označene
- Vsak član posadke mora poznati cone omejenega gibanja in ravnanje v takih primerih
- Vrata, razen tistih v uporabi morajo biti zaklenjena

AND ACT.....

- Get them out of the area
- If a visitor, escort them to the reception area.
- Report the incident to your immediate supervisor

# Sumljive osebe



## Pazi na ....

- Preveč ali čudno oblečene osebe
- Stojijo ali postopajo po hodniku ali prostoru
- Sprašujejo za neobičajne prostore ali osebe



# Sumljive osebe



**Pazi na osebe....**

- ki ne spadajo v to področje
- ki se gibajo od vrat do vrat itd...
- vstopajo v pisarno/kabino/prostор brez spremstva
- prodajajo predmete
- ki izgledajo izgubljeni

# Sumljive osebe



**AND ACT.....**

- **Immediately** report the incident to your immediate supervisor



# Suspicious Activity



## LOOK FOR ...

- Objects obstructing access points
- Disconnected or obstructed cameras
- Broken locks or access control systems
- Unexplained clutter or debris
- Objects thrown from a vehicle, especially while traveling at a high speed.

# Suspicious Activity



**ACT ...**

- **Immediately report** any suspicious activity to your supervisor.

- Kraja
- Sumljivi predmeti
- Preglej in preštej zaloge
- Tovorni prostori morajo biti zaprti


# Nenadzorovani predmeti

- V nivoju 1 je potrebno pregledovati po planu
- V nivoju 2 se pregleduje vse
- Če se najde sumljiv objekt je potrebno podvzeti vse preventivne mere
- Po potrebi se pregleda z metal detektorjem

# Suspicious Objects or Packages



## Identification of Suspicious Envelopes/Packages




## LOOK FOR....

- Unexplained objects or packages that look strange or do not belong to the area
- Strange markings on boxes (unknown code, color) or strange characteristics (weight, number, odd shape)
- Strange leaking substance (powder, liquid, etc...)
- Suspicious objects in the middle of an area (e.g., hallway, lobby, etc.)

# Suspicious Objects or Packages

## Identification of Suspicious Envelopes/Packages



### Items to consider:

1. No return address.
2. Excessive postage.
3. Restrictive markings such as "personal" or "confidential".
4. Addressed to someone no longer in office or department.
5. Items protruding from envelope/package.
6. wet areas, openings or strange odours.
7. Unusually heavy envelope/package, and/or
8. Presence of small bulges, powder or granules.

## AND ACT.....

- **Immediately report any suspicious packages or objects to your SSO**

- 1 Handle with care  
Don't shake or bump.
- 2 Isolate and look for indicators (shape, color, smell).
- 3 Don't open, smell, lick or taste.
- 4 Treat it as suspect!  
Report immediately.
